Ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying dogs that place in all height divisions. Rosettes or Flat ribbons available 1st – 4th for Novice thru Excellent
 Rosettes or Flat ribbons available 1st & 2nd for Novice thru Premier
 Flat ribbons available for 3rd and 4th Masters and Premier

Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

New Title Ribbons will be awarded to any dog achieving a new title.

A Rosette and Bar will be awarded to any dog achieving a MACH, PACH* or PAX* title.
 *If PAX & PACH are earned in the same trial only a PACH bar & Rosette will be awarded.

A Rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing their Agility Grand Championship

In order to acquire an agility title, a dog must earn three qualifying scores per class level under at least two different judges for Novice through Excellent A classes.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY OF DOGS is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

THE TRIAL WILL BE OPEN each day from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. **Entry fee:** \$24.00 first class each dog each day and \$13.00 additional class (as 2nd or 3rd run), same dog, same day (includes \$3.50 first run and \$3.00 each additional run AKC recording fee). **Makes checks payable to TBASSC.**

Jr Handlers (under 18 at time of trial, AKC Jr #, running dog owned by self or immediate family member) reduced entry fees will be \$18 first entry, \$10 2nd/3rd for same dog, same day (still includes same recording fees).

TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted. **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. **NO ONLINE ENTRIES ARE BEING TAKEN FOR THESE TRIALS.**

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be delivered to the USPS PO Box without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

TRIAL COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

ELECTRONIC TIMERS may be used for all classes

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

BITCHES IN SEASON will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the date of the trial. If a **sudden and unforeseen illness or injury** which prohibits a dog from competing occurs after closing entry fees may be refunded (less \$3 per run) upon receipt of certification from a veterinarian.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be mailed as soon as practicable after trial closes, and will include confirmation notices and judging schedule.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warmup area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to **the Trial Secretary in writing.** (EMail is acceptable.) All move-ups for the weekend must be received by the trial secretary no later than Monday, Sept 16th 2019 at **6PM**. Day to day move-ups will be accepted over the weekend. No moving down or changing or height after closing except as specified in Chapter 1 Section 21 of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive or blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

SITE INFORMATION

- Crating will be indoors on mats.
- Lunch will be provided for workers – there are numerous fast food restaurants within a few minutes of the site as well as many casual dining options. Water/soda available for a small donation.
- Please do not park in front of the Gymnastics facility
- Our ‘potty’ area is in the rear of the building. Do not allow your dog to potty in the grass in the front of the building or near any of the other businesses.
- No crates will be allowed in the ring area (Unit A)
- Dogs may not be left unattended in the building
- A warm up jump will provided on the same turf surface as the ring
- Chairs will be provided ring side for spectators. Please do not place your personal chairs in that area.
- Ring surface is the same turf as has been used at the invitational and Westminster.

Effective: June 1, 2019

Regulations for Agility Trials and Agility Course Test (ACT) to allow the use of head halters as follows:

Chapter 4, Section 9. Collars. At the handler’s option, dogs may run a course with or without a collar. The only collars allowed when running a course are flat buckle or rolled leather collars, but there shall be no attachments hanging or otherwise allowed on the collar. This shall not preclude painted or stitched designs or information on the collar. Dog’s names and/or identifying information may appear on the collar. No title, awards, or advertising may appear on the collar. Dogs may be brought to the start line on slip leads, choke chains, body harnesses, head halters or other collars that are permitted on the trial grounds. Pinch/prong and electrical collars (dummy or not), and special training collars are not allowed anywhere on the trial grounds.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
